

INFORMATION RE: UNDER 18s AT SAS HURLEY CLASSIC

Dear Parent/Guardian, we are delighted that your son/daughter has requested an entry for the SAS Hurley Classic. It is always very encouraging to see young talent coming through and developing by such experiences into potential champions of the future.

The following information is for parents/guardians of under 18 year olds. We wish you to be fully aware of the implications of your young person attending the event.

White water sports are an assumed risk activity. The event takes place on and around a white water weir and is for competent people in the various disciplines only. If water conditions are deemed by the Environment Agency to be extremely hazardous certain classes will be cancelled, this may or may not include the junior class.

By signing the parental consent you are giving your young person permission to paddle in the junior event in these conditions. If you are not happy with this, it is your duty to make the event organizer aware of any conditions you wish to place on them.

Outside of the entrants specific allotted competing time slots there is no organised safety cover for time spent on the water or at the event.

Please read the event details and check out the event films on You Tube and Facebook so that you are thoroughly aware of what is involved before you give consent. Please consider the above points carefully.

Your signed consent here is acceptance that you have considered the risks involved and that you are happy for your son/daughter to partake.

I hope that this information will not act as a deterrent in any way to your young person participating. I am always happy to chat through concerns with parents.
